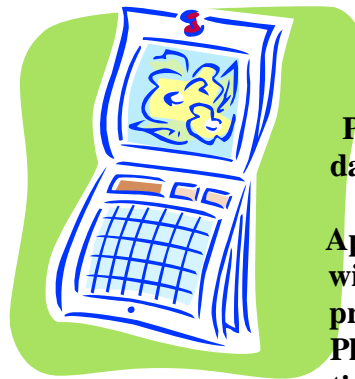
event. The Knights of Columbus meet will take place at the arena on April 16.
