### Inter-net Use Policy

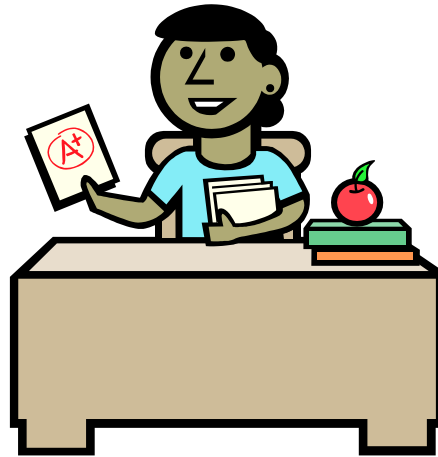
