Independent Auditor's Report

To the Board of Trustees:

Opinion

We have audited the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report greater than or equal to \$75,000 of the Mystery Lake School District for the year ended December 31, 2022.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted out audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Responsibilities of Management and Those Charged with Governance for the Public Sector Compensation Disclosure Report
