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#### **GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The District recognizes the right of parents to register their children in independent schools or to home school their children. The District reserves the right to deny requests of parents of home schooled students to participate in school based programs (academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular) to supplement home schooling. The District accepts no obligation to provide educational materials to students enrolled in an independent school or students being home schooled.

#### **Independent Schooling/Home Schooling**

Any resident parent choosing independent or home schooling must recognize the following:

The District will not accept partial enrollment of home schooled students to participate in school based programs (academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular) to supplement home schooling.

It is the parent's responsibility to satisfy the attendance requirements for school attendance. Parents wishing to home school must register their children with the [Home Schooling Office of Manitoba Education](#) and make all required reports to the Minister of Education or designate.

The District assumes no responsibility for the outcomes of the enrollment in independent schooling or home schooling.

The District retains the right to assess any student who has been registered in an independent school or home schooled and wishes to return to the District. Placement in an appropriate program will be based upon the recommendations of the District employees.

District sponsored assessment programs and activities shall not be available to students participating in any form of independent schooling.
