The Board of Trustees will erect and maintain upon the school building or on the school grounds a flagstaff and will cause the national flag of Canada to be

- a) flown on each day that the school is open.
- b) flown at half-mast in the case of the death of a student or present employee, at the school the student or employee attended or worked at and also the School Board Office. The flag will be half-mast on the day of the death or the following day, and the day of the funeral or memorial service.
- c) In observance of Remembrance Day:
 - If Remembrance Day falls on a weekend or a Monday, the flag will be lowered on Friday evening
 - If Remembrance Day falls on any other day of the week other than what is noted above, the flag will be lowered the evening before.
- d) Or if directed by the province of Manitoba or the Government of Canada.

In situations where the flag will be flown at half-mast for any reason other than stated in b and c above, staff will be notified and provided with an explanation.
