Students in the School District of Mystery Lake may graduate with one or more of the following diplomas:

Manitoba Diploma:	Student who achieves 30 credits and meets Manitoba Education Citizenship and Youth graduation requirements.
Mystery Lake Diploma with Distinction:	Students who meet the requirements for the Mystery Lake Diploma and achieve an average of 80% or greater in Grade 12 courses (minimum five Grade 12 credits, interpreted as the best five Grade 12 credits achieved, that includes all core subjects) will receive a silver or gold medal in addition to their diploma.
Manitoba French Immersion Diploma:	Out of a total of 30 credits, a minimum of 14 credits taught in French are required. At each grade in 9 and 10, a minimum of 4 credits must be completed in French. At each grade in 11 and 12, a minimum of 3 credits must be completed in French.
Mystery Lake Technical/Vocational Diploma:	Out of a total of 30 credits, 16 compulsory credits must be taken along with an approved cluster of 8 to 14 compulsory technology education credits.
Individualized Certificate Of Completion:	Students who receive an Individualized Programming designation and do not follow provincial curriculum because of their cognitive disability and do not acquire the credits to graduate. The eligibility for the certificate of completion must be approved by the school principal.

Students will receive diplomas at the graduation ceremony.
