



Vehicles on School Property

1. Parking Policy

Parking on school property shall be limited to designated areas only.

The Principal has authority and control over parking and traffic on the school property during school hours.

Student parking on school property may be authorized by the Principal.

Plugs shall be restricted to engine heaters only.

Overnight parking will not be allowed.

Snow will be cleared from parking lots by district owned equipment or by contracted equipment as time and budget permit. Parking lots shall have priority after fire exits and pedestrian entrances are cleared. The District does not assume responsibility for vehicles stuck due to snow conditions.

2. Traffic Controls

Vehicular traffic on school property is restricted to areas constructed for this purpose unless authorization to do otherwise is received from the Principal.

Vehicular traffic includes all motor drive vehicles including snowmobiles, motorcycles and all terrain vehicles.

The maximum speed limit on school property shall be 16 km. per Hour.

The Board authorizes the administrative staff to place the appropriate signs on District property as required to enforce traffic and parking controls.

The operation of vehicles shall at all times be in accordance with the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act and the By-Laws of the city.
