In the case of acts of vandalism on school property, every effort shall be made to collect restitution.

When large scale acts of vandalism have been committed, the discoverer shall inform the Principal or the Board Office if the Principal is unavailable. It shall be the Principal's duty to call the R.C.M.P. immediately and then the Board office.

Students who are found responsible for damage to or loss of school property including textbooks and library books will be assessed for such damage or loss by the Board or its agent and will be held responsible for such damage or loss until payment is made. Notices of assessment for damage or loss shall be forwarded to the student and/or the student's parent/guardian.
