

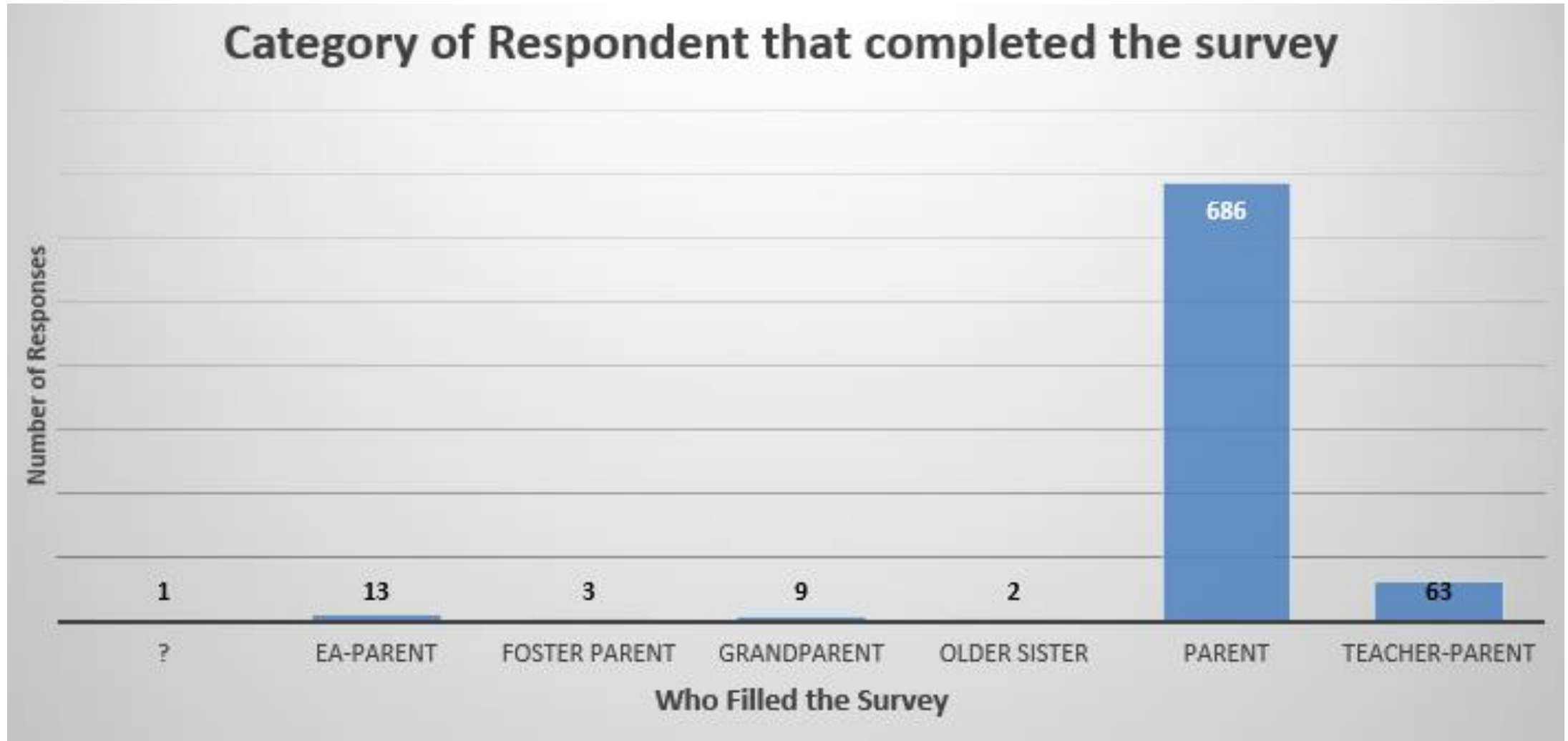

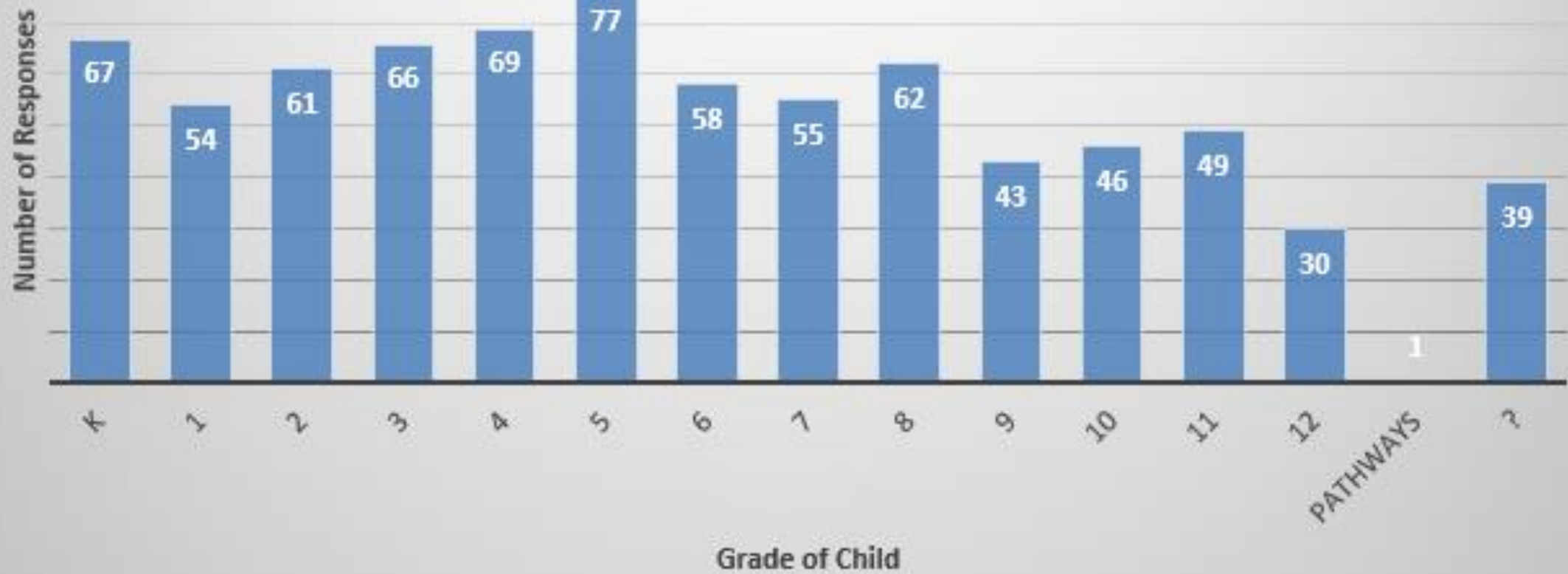

# Number of Survey Responses by School:

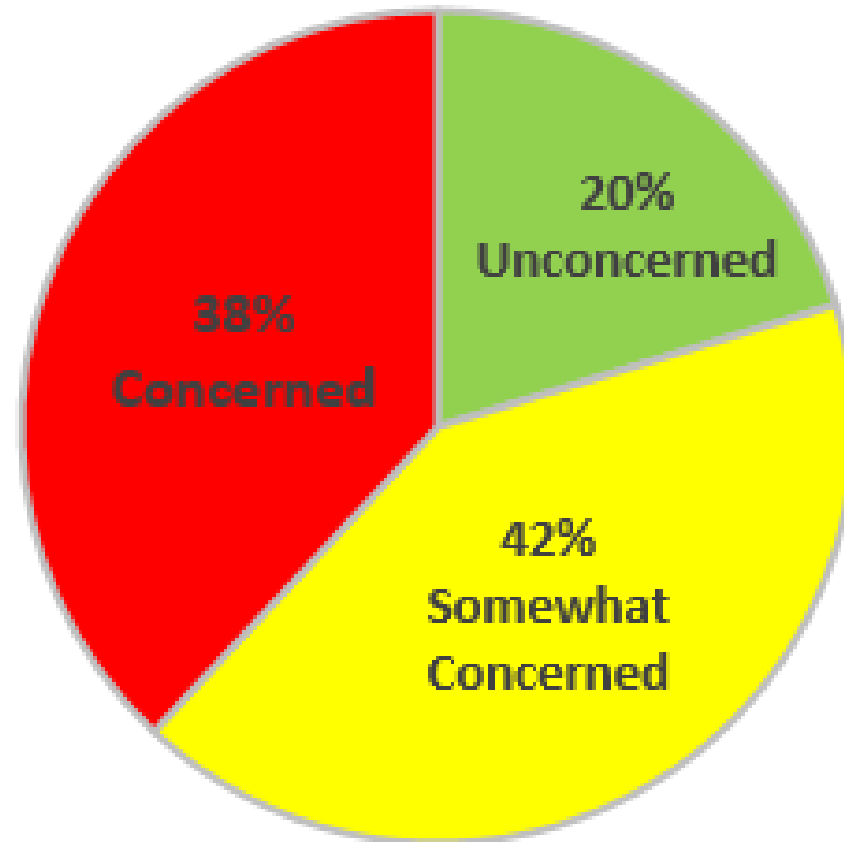

## Responses by Child's Grade

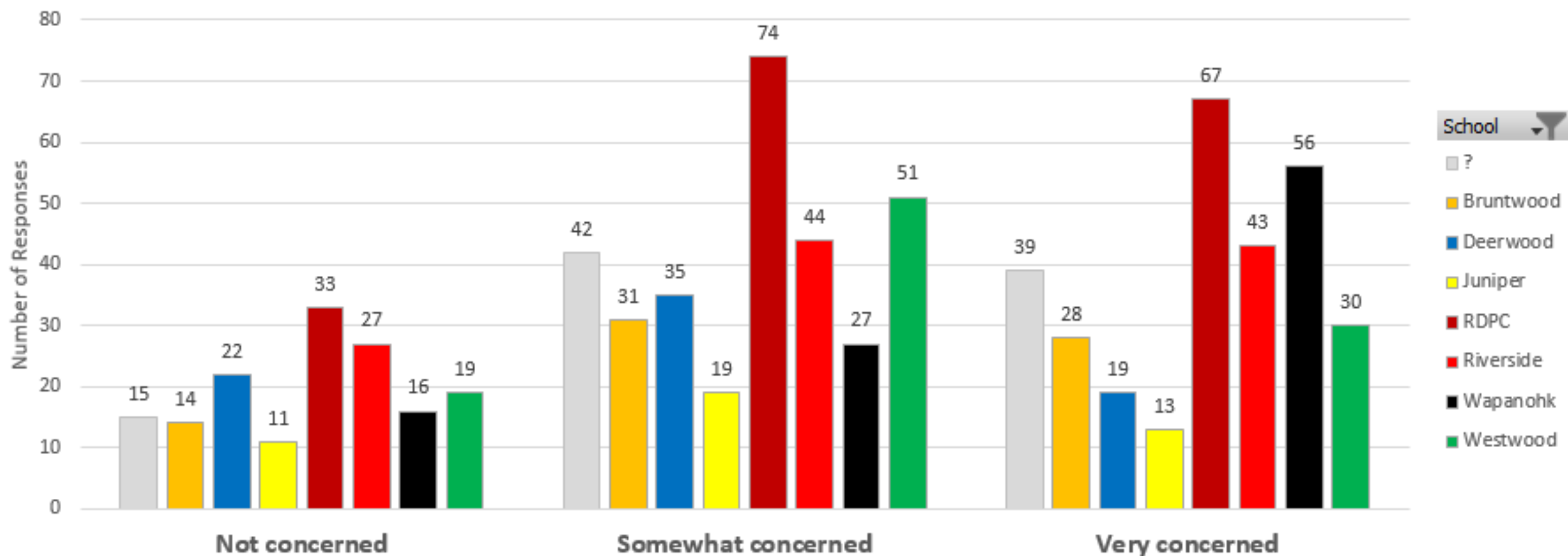


# Level of concern indicated toward **mental health and safety** regarding the SDML pandemic response

# Comments Regarding Health and Well-Being Concerns

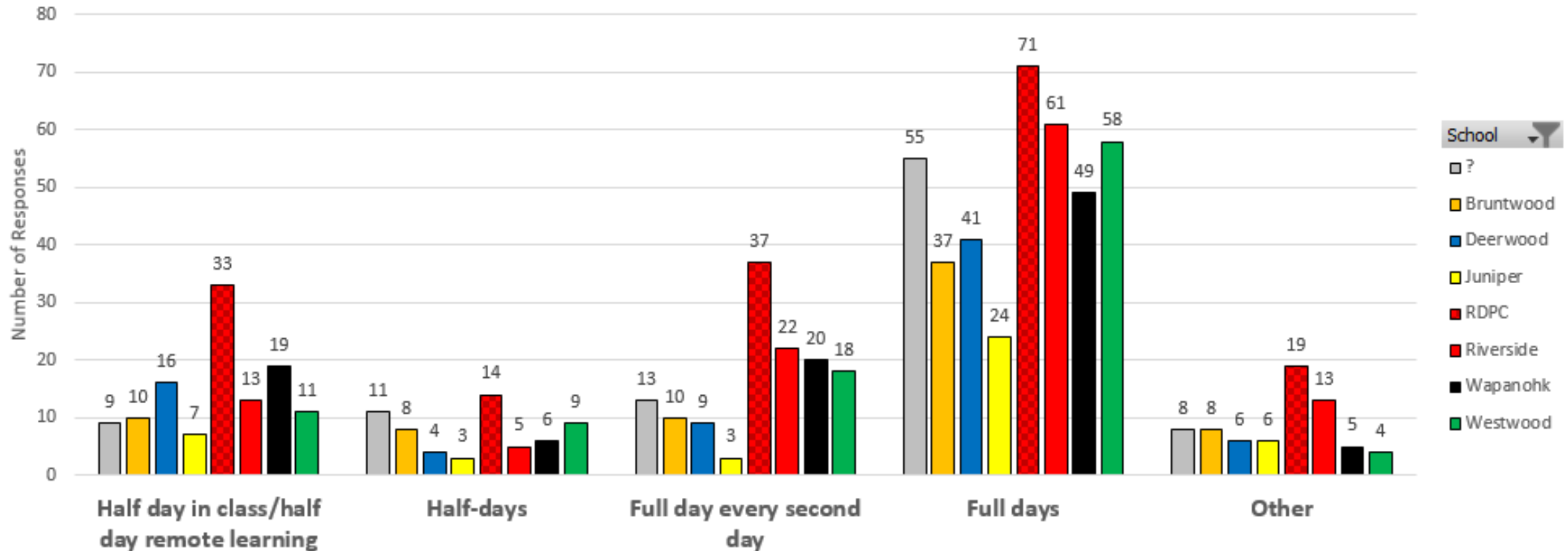
- **211 Written Responses**

Of these

- 112 concerned the Following Health & Safety Protocols and Physical Distancing
- 43 concerned the Maintaining of Sanitary Conditions in schools
- 41 concerned Mental Health and Supports in schools
- 69 concerned the Quality of Teaching and Learning
- 51 concerned the practice of Remote teaching and learning
- 4 explicitly discussed childcare

# Comments Regarding the Returning to School for Teaching & Learning

- **112 Written Responses**

Of these

- 13 discussed their interest in only having Remote Teaching and Learning
- 28 discussed their interest in having a Hybrid of Face-to-Face and Remote Teaching
- 20 discussed their interest in having students attend school on a rotation that included part time in school and part remote
- 9 discussed the need for structure and consistency
- 18 discussed their concerns for childcare

# Comments Regarding the Returning to School for Health and Safety

- **385 Written Responses**

Of these

- 160 indicated the need for a Comprehensive Plan that includes Transparent Communication
- 381 commented to Sanitization and/or possible use of masks
- 125 commented to Student-Parent workload and expectations on the parents/guardians to do the teaching and/or the need for a district-wide online platform
- 11 indicated their concern for Childcare
- 31 indicated their Health & Safety concerns
- 13 made congratulatory or positive comments to schools/staff
